After registering, you and all of your gear including instruments will be transported to Staff Camp Echo where you will have the remainder of the day to set up your tent and get organized.
You will be housed in Staff Camp Echo along with another band member.
Your meals will be in the Staff Dining Hall in Camp Echo.
There is a Trading Post at Echo for snacks, personal items, supplies, and official Jamboree items.

Church Service times and locations will be posted at Headquarters in Echo.
Report to the band tent at 2:00 pm on Sunday.
The band tent is located behind the stage in the stage in the Arena. Its about a 30 minute walk from Echo.
